# Episcopal Youth Event (EYE) 2020 Application



# Space is limited! Feb 1<sup>st</sup> deadline to apply!

**What is EYE:** EYE20 programs focus on helping develop leadership skills, spiritual practices, and early stages of vocational discernment. It is the second largest event in the Episcopal Church and the single largest youth event in the Episcopal Church, typically attended by some 1200 young people, adult sponsors, bishops, staff, and resource people. EYE is a once in a lifetime opportunity to gather with 1200 other young people.

**When is EYE?** EYE will be held July 8-10, 2020 at University of Maryland in College Park, MD. Our delegation will overnight together on July 5 then leave Seattle July 6 and spend a day in Washington DC on the 7<sup>th</sup>. We fly home on the 11<sup>th</sup>.

<u>Cost:</u> \$1000 a person. Cost includes: registration, lodging, meals, airfare, transportation, t-shirt and other costs. Scholarship assistance is available at 1/3 from the diocese. We would encourage you to also approach your parish for additional resources. There will also be a fundraising opportunity to help individuals offset some of the costs.

**Requirements to attend EYE 2017:** You must be a high school student in the 2019 – 2020 academic year, or for adult chaperones, over the age of 25. You must also be active in a congregation. Teenagers who are struggling with high anxiety and depression may find themselves under greater stress with travel and large scale interactions in unfamiliar places

All Youth AND Adults wishing to attend EYE must fill out the application and apply through the Diocese of Olympia. Please be aware the number of adult chaperones is strictly controlled and limited.

We will be taking a delegation that reflects the full breadth of the diocese in terms of cultural, ethnic, geographic, theological, gender, and economic ministry contexts present in our diocese.

Before sending this application to the Diocesan office: Please make sure that you have the signature of your parent(s)/guardian **AND** your priest/warden/youth leader!

Selection for the EYE team from Olympia will be based on this application and the goal of building a diverse team. On or before February 7th, the youth and adult chaperones who are selected will be notified.
