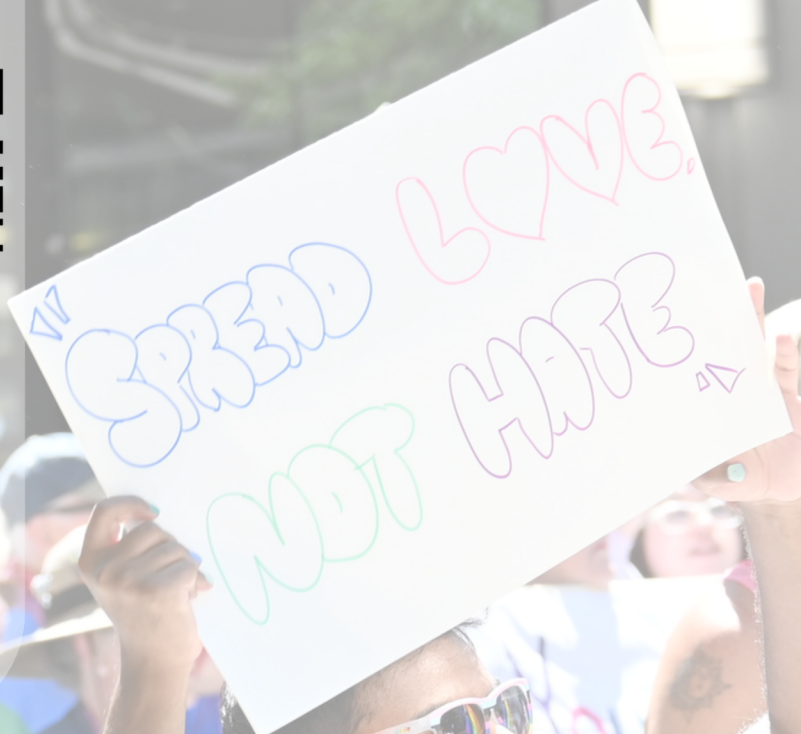
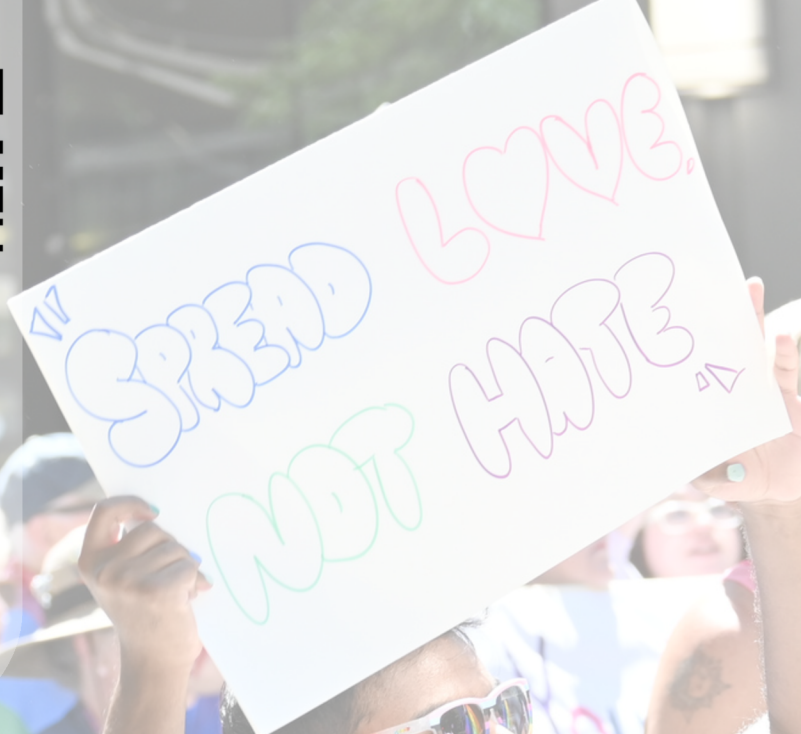

TIMELINE OF EPISCOPAL LEGISLATIVE ACTION

- 1974** - Women ordained as priests and elected as bishops.
- 1976** - The church votes for full inclusion, recognizing that all persons share a full and equal claim upon the love, acceptance, and pastoral concern and care of the church.
- 1994** - Sexual orientation added to the non-discrimination canons for aspiring priests.
- 2009** - "God's call is open to all." - a resolution passes to eradicate discriminatory barriers to the election of bishops.
- 2015** - Gender-neutral and same-sex marriage ceremonies officially adopted five days after the Supreme Court ruling.
- 2018** - The church votes to advocate for "federal legislation that protects transgender and gender non-conforming persons from discrimination."
